



How to Rescue a Seabird




Take your boat to the bird and lift it gently on board.


Wrap larger birds in a towel. If possible, cover its eyes.



Hold large birds' beaks shut, being careful of nostrils.



Use pliers to flatten the barb before gently removing the hook.



If the hook is swallowed, cut at entry point.

Allow tired, wet birds to recover before releasing onto the water.
